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## 2012 Jamboree Shakedown Information

The purpose of the 2012 Summit Shakedown is to test various components of the new jamboree model onsite at the new National Jamboree site, Summit Bechtel Reserve. 50 scouting units from councils across the country will be selected to participate in a "long weekend" starting on Friday morning, July 13 and ending on Tuesday morning, July 17 2012.

The Palmetto Council is interested in applying to send 1 troop of 36 scouts and 4 adult leaders to participate in this exciting sneak preview of the new Jamboree site and be "First on the Summit." Scouts wishing to be a part of our troop need to

- Complete the Palmetto Council Jamboree Shakedown application and submit a \$100.00 deposit.
- Interested scouts need to be at least a First Class Scout and 12 years old by the first day of the "Shakedown" or an 11 year old that has graduated the 6<sup>th</sup> grade, but has not reached their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday by the last day of the Jamboree "shakedown."
- Have a current BSA physical prior to the Jamboree Shakedown. Jamboree BMI standards will be enforced.
- Scouts will need the approval of their home troop Scoutmaster and the local council.
- Scouts wishing to participate in the Jamboree shakedown **DO NOT NEED TO BE REGISTERED TO ATTEND THE 2013 JAMBOREE.**

### Cost:

- The Palmetto Council has estimated that the cost for this event will be \$300.00 per participant. Participants need to submit a \$150.00 deposit with their application.
- You will be notified when to make the additional payment

### Included in cost:

- Transportation from home to the Summit and back.
- All meals beginning with lunch on day of arrival and ending with breakfast on day of departure.
- Tents, equipment, supplies, etc. similar to that which will be provided at the 2013 jamboree.
- Participants and staff will bring only their personal gear as is intended for the 2013 jamboree. Uniforms will be worn for travel to and from the Summit but will not be required during the onsite or offsite program activities.



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**Location:** Participants and staff will be housed in one of the sub camps in village C to be determined. Tents and cots will be those expected to be used at the jamboree.

**Daily Schedule and Program Content:** The particular program elements to be included will primarily be those which are new to the Summit jamboree model and are not intended to represent all of the program elements which will be offered in 2013. All staff and participants will be required to participate in a detailed evaluation process before, during and after the event to provide important feedback to the jamboree team to be used in the final planning process for the 2013 jamboree.

### Day by Day Schedule:

#### Wednesday 11 July:

Leadership staff and logistics staff arrive.

#### Thursday 12 July:

High adventure and sub camp operations staff arrive and setup program and sub camp facilities in conjunction with professional program consultants and project construction team.

#### Friday 13 July:

Participants arrive in morning (7am to 9am) at Summit welcome center by bus and will then be checked into sub camp. Set up camp and conduct orientation in campsites under the supervision of the Summit operations, logistics and program teams.

Lunch in campsites.

High adventure program by patrols. Possible program elements (subject to change) are climbing, rappelling, canopy tour, zip lines, BMX, skateboarding, mountain biking, shooting sports, and archery. There will be no aquatics activities onsite.

Dinner in campsites followed by evaluation of all activities for that day.



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Saturday 14 July:

Breakfast in campsites and assemble lunch.

Garden Ground Mountain staff arrive and setup program facilities on GGM.

High adventure program by patrols. Possible program elements (subject to change) are climbing, rappelling, canopy tour, zip lines, BMX, skateboarding, mountain biking, shooting sports, and archery. There will be no aquatics activities onsite. Lunch will be consumed in the high adventure program areas.

Dinner in campsites followed by evaluation of all activities for that day.

Sunday 15 July:

Breakfast in campsites and assemble lunch.

Interfaith worship service.

High adventure staff depart.

Hike to Garden Ground Mountain. Lunch and Program at summit. Hike back to campsites.

Service project onsite (optional - to be determined)

Dinner in campsites followed by evaluation of all activities for that day.

Monday 16 July:



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Breakfast in campsites and assemble lunch.

Garden Ground Mountain staff depart.

Offsite high adventure program by patrols. Possible program elements (subject to change) are whitewater rafting and technical rock climbing.

Dinner in campsites followed by evaluation of all activities for that day.

Closing campfire program.

### Tuesday 17 July:

Breakfast in campsites.

Breakdown of campsites. Participants depart by 11:00 am.

Operations staff begin departure process at 11:00 am. All staff depart by 5:00 pm.

This is an exciting opportunity for youth and adults to be among the first to camp at the Summit Bechtel Reserve and to play an important role in the final planning process for the 2013 National Scout Jamboree. Fill out and submit your application as soon as possible and become part of the first troops to visit the Summit..
