

# High Adventure Extravaganza

**When:** Friday March 12<sup>th</sup> 7pm through Sunday March 14<sup>th</sup> 10am

**Who:** Venture Crews, Venture Patrols and Boy Scouts 14 to 17 years old

**Where:** Camp Bob Hardin

**Why:** Just to have a great time doing some things that everyone enjoys and maybe win some prizes in the process.

**Event:** The High Adventure Extravaganza will be run like a contest with awards presented to the first, second and third place winners of each event at the end of the day. There will be five events Archery, Small-Bore Rifle Shooting, Shotgun Shooting, Climbing and Rappelling and Canoeing Slalom. Due to time limitations, there will be only 80 participants. The participants will be divided into five groups of sixteen each. The groups will rotate from activity to activity until all the activities have been completed.

**Score Cards:** Each participant will be given a score card. The participant will be responsible for keeping up with his or her scores card and will turn the score card in at the end of the day's activities.

1. At the Rifle Shooting event the participant will fire 3 shots to sight in the rifle, then 3 shots for practice and finally 10 shots for score. There will be a total of 16 shots fired by each participant.
2. At the Shotgun Shooting event the participant will fire 3 practice shots and then 10 shots for score. There will be a total of 13 shots fired by each participant.
3. At the Archery event the participant will shoot 3 arrows for practice and then 10 arrows for score. There will be a total of 13 arrows shot.
4. At the Canoeing Slalom event the participants will be divided into 8 teams of 2 scouts each. Each team will paddle through the designated course. The team with the fastest time through the course will win.
5. At the Climbing and Rappelling event the participants will rappel and climb on all 4 sides of the climbing tower. This will be a fun event only. Due to the nature of the event, there will be no score given.

**Awards:** There will be awards presented for First, Second and Third place winners in the Rifle Shooting, Shotgun Shooting, Archery and Canoeing Slalom events. In the case of the Canoeing Slalom event where there will be teams of 2 scouts competing, there will be 2 First, Second and Third place awards presented. In the event of a tied score, a shoot off will be conducted(time permitting).

**What is the cost?** The cost is \$20 per person which covers the cost for ammunition, targets and other materials. You must bring your own food and water along with gear for cooking and camping. Adirondacks will be available for most people to stay in but having a tent in your vehicle would be a wise choice as well.

**How do I sign up?** Just visit the council's estore at [www.palmettocouncil.org/estore](http://www.palmettocouncil.org/estore) to register and pay for the event. Once you login to the estore site you will see the link for the High Adventure Extravaganza. Click on the link and type in your information and proceed to the checkout o pay by credit card.

*Note: there are only 80 total spots available, we will cut off registration once we reach 80 so do not wait until the last minute.*
