Go 5 blocks and turn right onto Converse Street (First Baptist Church will be on your right at the corner of Main Street and Converse Street.) 4. Go two blocks and turn left onto Commerce Street (The Hanger is on your left between Dunbar and Commerce streets.) 5. Continue past The Hanger on Commerce Street and turn left into The Hanger's parking lot. |
| From Union | <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Take US 176 (Pine Street) into Spartanburg 2. Turn left onto Main Street (US 29, FedX/Kinkos will be across Main Street on your left at the corner of US 176 and Main Street.) 3. Follow directions 3 through 5 above. |
| From Woodruff | <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Take US 221 (Church Street) into Spartanburg 2. Go two blocks past Spartanburg Main Street 3. Turn right onto Commerce Street 4. Go past the Bus Station and turn right into The Hanger's parking lot. |
